


- Would you continue to worship God if, from this day forward, God's miraculous signs and wonders were not so profoundly evident in your life?

"You Samaritans worship what you do not know; we worship what we do know, for salvation is from the Jews"


#### HOW TO DO TRUE WORSHIP?

## NEW lifestyle of TRUE WORSHIPER




#### **✓ DEAL WITH YOUR SIN**

- In Old Testament Worship equalled sacrifice. Why is sacrifice necessary???
- Sacrifice is for remittance of Sin and getting acceptance in God's sight

#### GARDEN OF EDEN

- (Gen 1: 26-29; 2: 8-9, 15-17) GOD has made new covenant with ADAM
- ✓ Adam's part was to "multiply and fill the earth" and "to dress and keep it" and rule over all that God had created on the earth as God would instruct and guide him
- ✓ FALL OF HUMANITY- When Adam and Eve disobeyed God and sinned they brought on themselves the curse of death, and because they were unrepentant they were expelled from the Garden of God's pleasure (Eden)

(Gen 3: 6, 22-24)







# INHERITANCE of KINGDOM OF GOD

✓ (I Cor 6: 9-11; Rev 21: 7-8)






# CONFESSING THE SINS BEFORE GOD

- Gal 5: 19 21 "The acts of the flesh are obvious: sexual immorality, impurity and debauchery; idolatry and witchcraft; hatred, discord, jealousy, fits of rage, selfish ambition, dissensions, factions and envy; drunkenness, orgies, and the like. I warn you, that those who live like this will not inherit the kingdom of God."
- Gal 5: 22 24 "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law. Those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires"

# The Life of ABRAHAM

- Because of his faith and obedience God confirmed His covenant with him (Gen 26:1-5)
- Faith made God call Abraham His friend
- God reveals a truth in the mount Moriah That God Himself will provide a sacrifice lamb (Jesus) in the place of Isaac (for humanity)

#### UNPLEASING AND PLEASING SACRIFICE

✓ Life of King Saul and King David:


- ✓ King Saul Disobeyed God and took a portion of what God asked to destroy (I Samuel 15). And he lies to Prophet Samuel (I Sam 15: 13) and to God (15: 15)
- ✓ God Not only rejected his offering and Sacrifice (Worship), He also rejected Saul forever and overthrew him as king
- √"To do justice and judgment is more acceptable to the Lord than sacrifice", "The sacrifice of the wicked is abomination" (Prov 21:3, 27).



- DAVID replaced SAUL
- DAVID Sinned but repented and never continued SIN- Psalm 51
- He was forgiven by God and God made his name great. "After removing Saul, he made David their king. God testified concerning him: 'I have found David son of Jesse, a man after my own heart; he will do everything I want him to do'." Acts 13:22
- Proverb 28: 13 -
- ✓ He who conceals his transgressions will not prosper, But he who
  confesses and forsakes them will find compassion



# WORSHIP IS AN OUTPOUR OF OUR LOVE FOR GOD



- Matthew 22: 37 -38 Jesus said, "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind. This is the first and greatest commandment
- John 14:15 "If you love me you will keep my commandments". John 14: 23 Jesus "Anyone who loves me will obey my teaching".

- Love your neighbour as yourself :
- Romans 12: 9
- "Love must be sincere. Hate what is evil; cling to what is good."
- I Corinthians 13: 4 8 "Love is patient, love is kind. It does not envy, it does not boast, it is not proud. It does not dishonor others, it is not self-seeking, it is not easily angered, it keeps no record of wrongs, love does not delight in evil but rejoices with the truth. It always protects, always trusts, always hopes, and always perseveres. Love never fails".



## HOW to impress GOD?

- Matthew 22: 39 "Love your neighbor as yourself"
- Matthew 5: 24, 25 "Therefore, if you are offering your gift at the altar and there remember that your brother or sister has something against you, leave your gift there in front of the altar. First go and be reconciled to them; then come and offer your gift."
- Matthew 5: 7 "Blessed are the merciful, for they will be shown mercy"
- Matthew 5: 38, 39 "You have heard that it was said, 'Eye for eye, and tooth for tooth'. But I tell you, do not resist an evil person. If anyone slaps you on the right cheek, turn to them the other cheek also."
- Matthew 6: 14 "If you forgive other people when they sin against you, your Heavenly Father will also forgive you." If we do not do as God commanded, our worship and assembly will be despised by god
